
Week 11

Activities for three (3) year old



Monday

Making a Busy Board

- Collect some recyclable materials
- Stick materials on board
- Child has to manipulate all the materials: unzip, turn, fasten etc.

Physical Activity: Mini Golf Game

- Using a large cardboard box cut out hole and design with character of choice
- Child will stand at a distance from the box and use a broom handle/ stick to guide a ball into the hole



Tuesday

Assembling a Pop -Up Book

- Fold all the paper you need for the story pages in half
- Cut two parallel slits in the centre of the paper
- Open the paper and gently pull the tab forward
- Colour in the background for each page
- Stick story illustrations onto the tabs
- Make the book cover by folding construction paper in half and gluing to the end of the pages



- -Draw a straight line on the ground
- -Child chooses his/her favourite book and place on head
- -Child walks on the line while balancing the book





Wednesday

Making a model of your favourite toy

- Collect recyclable materials
- Assemble materials to create a specific toy





Thursday

Building a bottle Water fall

- Using six large plastic bottles, follow the pattern to create a water fountain
- Set up a water-filling station and add cups, buckets and containers



Physical Activity: Feed the Shark

- Create a model as seen in the picture
- Call out letters and allow the child to run, find it and feed the shark

Physical Activity: Monster Toss

- Using two plastic bottles (5 litres)
- Cut out mouth and create monster of your choice
- Crumple pieces of paper or aluminium foil into balls
- Toss balls into the monster's mouth
- Count how many balls are in the monster





Creating an Edible Shape Book

- Use lettuce for the font and back cover
- Slice cheese into squares
- Use tomatoes as circles
- Cut sausage into triangles
- Eat and discuss shape



Physical Activity: Finger/Air Hockey

- Using cardboard or a pizza box create a model as seen in the picture
- Cut out and paint ten small circles
- The child has to get his/ her circle through the slot
- This must be done until he/she gets all their circles on the other side
