



To solve a problem, you must decide what you need to find out and do.



- 3. Ramesh and Rita borrowed 6 books each from the library. How many books did they borrow in total?


Subtraction

When we subtract, we take one number away from another.




'ea' sometimes makes the long 'e' sound. Draw a line from the picture to match with the word and say the word.




