The sea - Salt is removed from sea water so that we can drink it

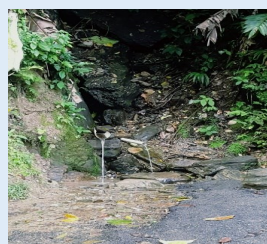


Reservoirs/Dam - A reservoir is a large area for the storing of water

Orishas - attending the **Oshun Festival** at Clifton Hill









We need and depend on water to live. Many adults also depend on water from our rivers and the ocean to earn a living to take care of themselves and their families.



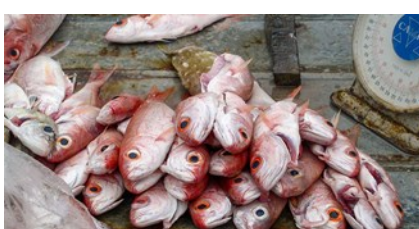
