dada	da	papa	pa	daddy


Today, a **father figure** may also be grand-dad, step or adopted parent, uncle, brother, or even a mentor.

TOOL	NAME OF TOOL	USE
	Garden fork	To dig up the soil into large pieces
	Cutlass	To cut branches on trees
	Hoe	To remove weeds and till the soil
	Watering can	To water plants
	Rake	To gather leaves and prepare soil for planting
