Obeying all rules and laws For boys ONLY-Scouts




#### Review of the letters s,a,t,i

Circle the pictures on each line with the same **beginning** sound as the first picture.




#### End sounds

Say the name of the pictures. Say the sound you hear at the end of the words.




Say the name of the pictures. Circle the correct letter for the **end sound** of each word.




#### **Plane Shapes**

#### Find the Shapes








#### **Matching Patterns**


