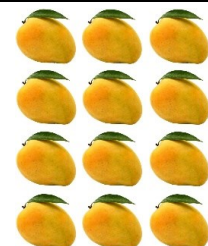

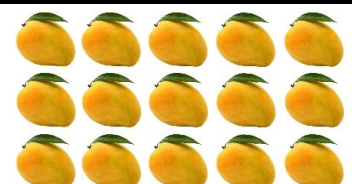

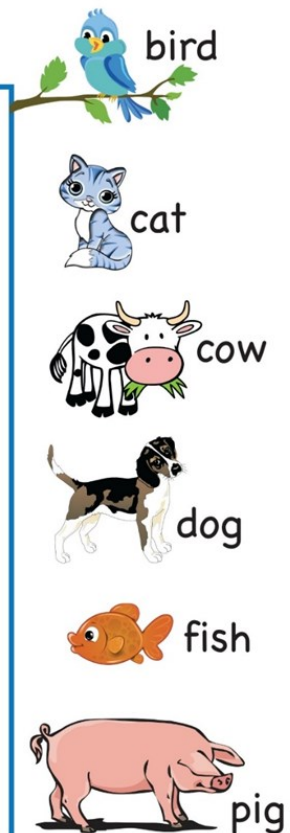
Health Corner

Keeping clean is very important during the Covid-19 pandemic. Here are some tips to encourage your child to practice good personal hygiene.



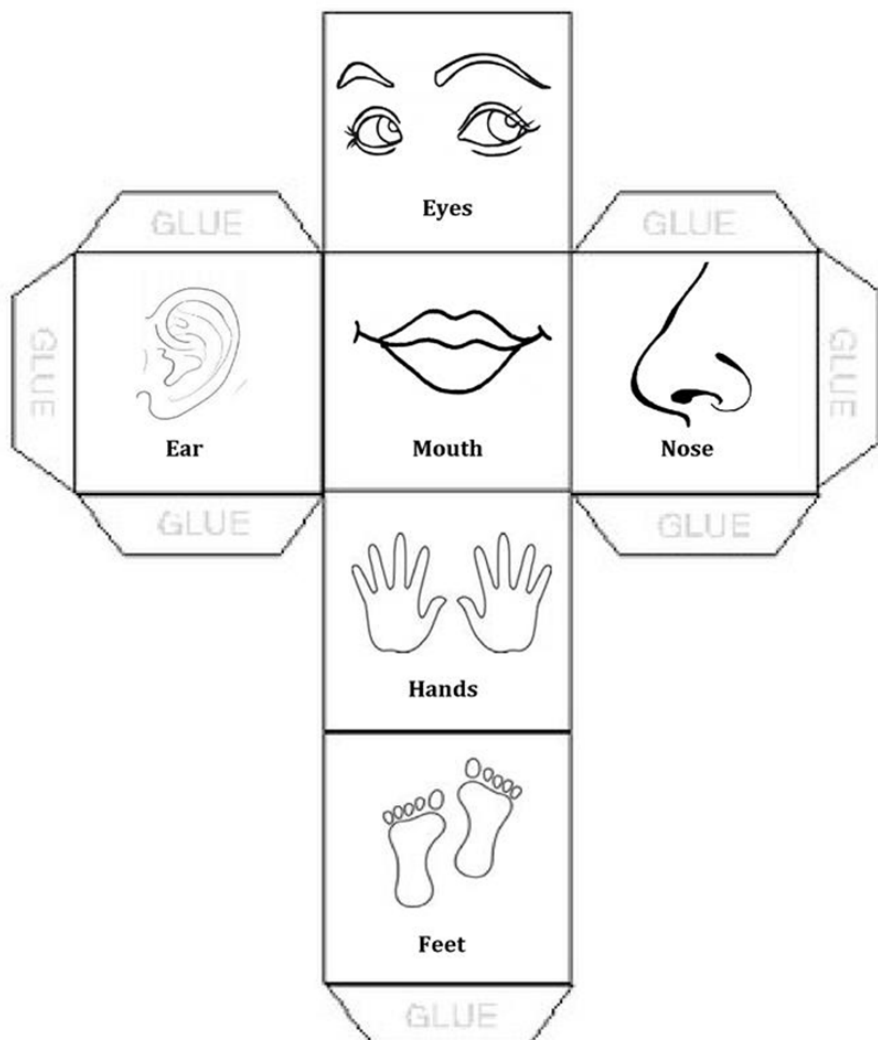
